This picture went viral in 2015 as it sparked debate over the dress's color. When it was revealed that the dress was actually black and blue, people began to ask why there were such differences in color perception.

In the case of the dress, variations in color perception resulted from how our brains interpreted the lighting depicted in the photo. If the brain assumes that the dress is dimly lit, it will appear white and gold. However, if the brain thinks the dress is brightly illuminated, it will conclude that the dress is much darker, making it appear black and blue.
